2021 EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS (CAGs)

APPEALS PROCESS

The process of calculating the CAGs was based on 10% Diagnostic, 10% CAs (best 3 taken in school over two years) and 80% on the Mock results. These scores were then placed on grade boundaries. Any grade sent to the relative awarding bodies was a proposal which may have changed or remained the same after review and sampling.

Request for Appeal to the Awarding Bodies (Edexcel and AQA)

This is the second stage of appeal that is submitted to the awarding bodies by the centre. It can only be requested after the student has received the outcome of the Stage 1, Centre Review appeal. The student will fill in an online form.

It is based on the grounds that the student considers that there has been:

- 1. a procedural error,
- 2. an administrative error or
- 3. that their grade reflects an unreasonable exercise of academic judgement.

If a student wishes to withdraw the request, the awarding bodies will accept this so long as no decision has been made.

An application for an awarding organistion appeal cannot be withdrawn once a finding has been made.

When an application for an appeal is received, the awarding organisation will decide whether it will be accepted for evalution or not. If accepted, the resulting outcome may be that the grade is raised, stays the same or is lowered.
