Introduction

This document has been designed to assist students and parents/ carers when applying for external exams through The English School.

The English School is an accredited examinations centre for Pearson/ Edexcel, Cambridge International and AQA exam boards and delivers GCSE, IGCSE, Level 2 Certificate, GCE (AS/ A2), IAS and IAL examinations.

Accessing the Registrations System

Students will be able to access the exams registrations system through the school's website under Login Links, Exams Portal (www.englishschool.ac.cy > Login > Exams Portal). Students should use their Microsoft Office 365 school's account login details to enter into the system. The username is their student number (i.e. s*****).

External Examinations Important Information

1) Exam registrations window

The school's Summer 2025 session exam registrations window is the **18th November to 2nd December 2024**. Kindly note that:

- a) ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE DURING THE ABOVE-MENTIONED PERIOD.
- b) **ANY NEW UNIT ENTRIES MADE AFTER THIS TIME WILL BE CHARGED WITH A LATE PENALTY FEE OF €50.**
- c) A double or even triple registration fee may be incurred by the Exam Boards after certain deadlines. Please refer to point 11 below for further information.

2) Expected exams for the academic year

The school's policy for external exam registrations is that all students register through the school during the summer exams session for the exams of each subject followed and prepared for at school. The exams students should register during the current academic year are indicated on the **Expected Entries** email forwarded to each student by the Exams Office before the November registrations window. Furthermore, expected entries are automatically displayed under each student in the Exams Portal.

Please refer to **Appendix 1** for the expected entries lists per year group.

3) Confirming personal details

Upon confirmation of exam entries through the school's registrations system, students also confirm their personal details are correct, i.e., spelling of name and date of birth align with their details as shown on the government ID and birth certificate. If any of the details are incorrect, please inform the Exams Office immediately by uploading a legal document such as a birth certificate, through the exams registration system. Failure to do so will result in Exam Boards issuing certificates with the wrong name.



Exam Boards charge a fee for reprinting certificates after the summer session's results are out (September onwards) and provide a confirmation statement (not a certificate reprint) after December.

4) Out of school exams

The school is allowed to accept registrations **from students currently enrolled with the school and only for the exams of the subjects followed and prepared for at school.**

Any exams for subjects studied outside the school will not be accepted **unless they clash (scheduled for the same day and same time or time overlaps) with an exam studied at school.** If this is the case, students will need to register for the clashing exams through the school.

We strongly recommend student who intend to take out of school exams during the summer session to contact the Exams Office and check there are **no clashes** with the exams they will take at school. Please contact the Exams Office (exams@englishschool.ac.cy) to **check and confirm this, before registering with another exams centre.**

Students interested to register for exams in subjects followed out of school may register through the British Council or any other exams centre that can accept registrations from private candidates.

It is extremely important that students registering for exams out of school with Exam Boards Pearson/ Edexcel or AQA should use the **same Unique Candidate Identifier (UCI) number for all their exams.** The UCI number is mentioned on students' Provisional Statement of Results issued by the Exam Boards when the results are out.

If students do not mention their UCI number upon registration with the British Council, then the British Council will issue a new UCI number for them. When a student has multiple UCI numbers this would result in not all units banked under the same person by the Exam Board. Therefore, the student would not be able to receive the qualification's result and certificate when the time comes.

It is the responsibility of students and parents to resolve any issues arising with out of school registrations directly with the alternative Exams Centre (i.e., British Council).

5) Payments

Please complete the payment of exam fees online by 6th December, through JCC Smart. To initiate the payment through JCC Smart platform:

- a) Access the link: [Electronic invoices: JCCsmart portal](#)
- b) Locate the relevant category: **Exams – May/June Registration Fees**
- c) Click on '**Bill payment**' under the relevant category
- d) Complete the form with the necessary information required:
 - Student name/surname, Student number, Class
 - Invoice number (as stated on the invoice issued after confirming your exams)
 - Amount (as stated on the invoice issued after confirming your exams)
- e) Proceed with completing the payment

Payments can be made **until Friday, 6th December 2024**. Applications will not normally be accepted after this deadline.

The school will not be able to submit your summer exam registrations to the Exam Boards, if you fail to confirm your exams and settling the total fee due by the assigned deadlines.

6) Refunds for cancellations or changes to entries

If you receive approval for cancelling an expected exam registration during the registrations window (18 November - 2 December 2024) and you have already paid the fee due, the school's Finance Office will process your refund by late December.

Full refund of the exam fees paid is provided for withdrawals made before the **20th February for Cambridge International** and before the **21st March for Pearson/ Edexcel and AQA**. After these deadlines, the school cannot guarantee that the fees will be returned as this will be at the discretion of the Exam Board involved. Cambridge International usually does not provide a refund after their deadline of mid-February.

Exams withdrawal without prior approval by the Exam Boards are possible until **22nd April**. When students have already completed part of the syllabus component for a subject (i.e., coursework or speaking exams), the Exam Boards will not allow withdrawal of the registration entry for the subject. If the Exam Board does not accept to withdraw an entry, the students will receive an "X" on their Provisional Statement of Results issued by the Exam Board when the results are out in August.

The school's Finance Office will process refunds for all approved exam cancellations after the exams' withdrawal deadline. The refunded fee is usually deposited in the student's school tuition fees account, with the exception of Year 7 students or students leaving the school with no outstanding balance.

7) Cash-in codes for Pearson/ Edexcel IAS (Year 6) & IAL (Year 7) qualifications

Year 6 students are expected to undertake IAS exams for the subjects followed at school. Year 7 students are expected to undertake IAL exams for the subjects followed at school.

Pearson/ Edexcel IAS and IAL subjects have cash-in codes for issuing qualification results and certificates once the relevant units have been completed. All candidates completing a qualification under IAS and IAL must enter the relevant cash-in code as part of their registration for the subject. Failure to do so will result in not receiving the qualification's grade when results are out in August. Further, the relevant certificate will not be issued for the candidate.

Cash-in codes required for IAS and IAL qualifications will show on the Expected Entries document emailed to students by the Exams Office before the November registrations window. They are automatically allocated in the Exams Portal and will thus be confirmed together with



the rest of the exams for the year. You can check your cash-in codes for the current academic year in **Appendix 1**.

Any late cash-in code requested after the applications deadline are subject to a fee of €80.

a. Year 6 and Year 7 students following double Maths:

Year 6 students following double maths (IAS Mathematics and IAS Further Mathematics) and Year 7 students following double maths (IAL Mathematics and IAL Further Mathematics) will have a cash-in code for each qualification. These appear separately on students' Estimated Entries and in the Exams Portal due to aggregation of units for each qualification.

Year 7 students following double maths at school will have the IAS cash-in codes together with their IAL cash-in codes for Mathematics and Further Mathematics (i.e., four cash-in codes).

Furthermore, Year 7 students who followed double maths in Year 6 but continued with single maths in Year 7 will have the IAS Further Mathematics cash-in code together with their IAL Mathematics cash-in code (i.e., two cash-in codes).

According to Pearson's aggregation regulations, this allows grade maximisation to take place and does not lead to any disadvantages. Pearson's Mathematics Aggregation Rules & Guidance document has been posted in Teams for the attention of double maths students by Ms Elena Kazantzi on 16th September.

8) Personal Exams Schedule

About a month before the external exams begin, the Exams Office will provide through Form Tutors a Personal Exams Schedule to all students having external exams. This document provides important information to students such as the candidate's personal details, candidate number, any clash arrangements, the exam papers date and time, allocated venue and seat number. The relevant details are also forwarded to students via emails.

Any errors on this document such as spelling of names, date of birth or subjects **MUST be communicated immediately to the Exams Office by email to exams@englishschool.ac.cy.**

During the exams period, students should check their schedule and know where they are going (room and seat number). Furthermore, they should remember their **candidate number**, as they will need to add this on all their exam papers.

9) Clashes

Clashes are exams scheduled by the Exam Boards on the same date and same time (or time overlaps). When there is a clash, the Exams Office follows the Exam Boards' instructions for handling the clash. **Information about any clash arrangements will be communicated to students on their Personal Exams Schedule.**



Students with a clash undertake all clashing exam papers in a separate exam room from the rest of the students. Further, there is a Supervised Break between clashing exam papers.

During the Supervised Break students may study, eat and rest until their next exam. They will not have access to any electronic devices such as mobile phones and they are not allowed to communicate with any individuals other than the invigilators, Exams Office personnel and students in the exam room having the same clash.

10) Access Arrangements

Students requesting to apply for any Access Arrangements you need to contact the school's Exams Office (exams@englishschool.ac.cy) as soon as possible and **no later than middle of December**, by submitting the relevant diagnostic assessment report.

Access Arrangements are agreed before the exams period. They allow candidates with substantial impairments such as special educational needs ('learning difficulty or disability which calls for special educational provision to be made for them' 'substantial and long-term sensory impairments such as those affecting sight or hearing, mental health difficulties and long-term health conditions) or disabilities ('physical or mental impairment which has a substantial and long term adverse effect on someone's ability to carry out normal day to day activities') to access the assessment and show what they know and can do without changing the demands of the assessment. The intention behind Access Arrangements is to meet the particular needs of an individual candidate without affecting the integrity of the assessment.

Any arrangements put in place must reflect the support given to the student in school in the classroom, during internal school tests and mock examinations and thus **should be the normal way of working for the student**. The school should be able to show a history of support and provision for the student. This arrangement cannot be granted suddenly to candidates at the time of their examinations.

Late applications for temporary injuries or impairment, such as a fractured or broken writing hand or pain and discomfort caused due to surgery which occurred during the examination period, are permissible after this deadline.

If a candidate has never made use of an arrangement granted to them and it is not their normal way of working, the school can withdraw this provision.

11) Late Registration Fees

The English School Late Fees: After the two-weeks window the school will charge a flat fee of €50 on any unit entry made.

Exam Boards Late Fees: All entries deadline by **20th February**. Late entry fees will be charged as follows, after this deadline:

21st February to 21st April: double the unit fee

22nd April onwards: triple the unit fee (provided the Exam Board accepts the registration)

Confirm

On the **Exam Selections** screen, you will view your Unique Candidate Identifier (UCI) numbers for Exam Boards Pearson/ Edexcel and AQA. Exam Board Cambridge does not issue UCI numbers. The school allocates a provisional UCI number to students who are registering with Pearson or AQA for the first time. Upon submission of registrations to each Exam Board, the Exam Board locks each student's UCI number by adding a capital letter to the end of the provisional number provided by the school.



If you have sat exams with Pearson/ Edexcel or AQA in the past, find your Provisional Statement of Results issued by the Exam Board when the results are out in August and check this is the same number. If incorrect, please inform Ms. Elena Kazantzi via email (elena.kazantzi@englishschool.ac.cy).

Step 4 - Review your exam units

The **Exam Selections** page mentions your summer exams Expected Entries for the academic year. Please carefully review all subjects and exams mentioned on this page and compare them with the Expected Entries document provided to students by email. If there are any inconsistencies with the codes or subjects, please inform Ms. Elena Kazantzi via email (elena.kazantzi@englishschool.ac.cy).
