In an effort to keep you informed, we are writing to bring to your attention some of the upcoming sessions that your son/daughter has been advised of:

#### UCAS Apply Sessions

The purpose of the UCAS Apply Sessions is for students to 'register' on UCAS and to begin the process of completing their UCAS Application, before school ends for the summer break. If they have yet to register for one of these sessions, then please encourage them to do so.

#### Personal Statement Workshops

We are offering additional Personal Statement Workshops in June for any students who were unable to attend in April.

#### Question and Answer Session

An opportunity for students to come in and ask questions or receive additional information regarding any aspect of their application before school ends for the summer break.

#### Part 2 – UKCAT follow up course

Open not only to students who attended Part 1, but also to any other students who will need to take the UKCAT this summer.

#### LNAT preparation days

Open to students who will be applying to study Law and who will need to take the LNAT test.

STEP/MAT preparation classes

We continue to run MAT and/or STEP preparation classes to assist those who will need to take the test as part of their university course's entry requirements.
